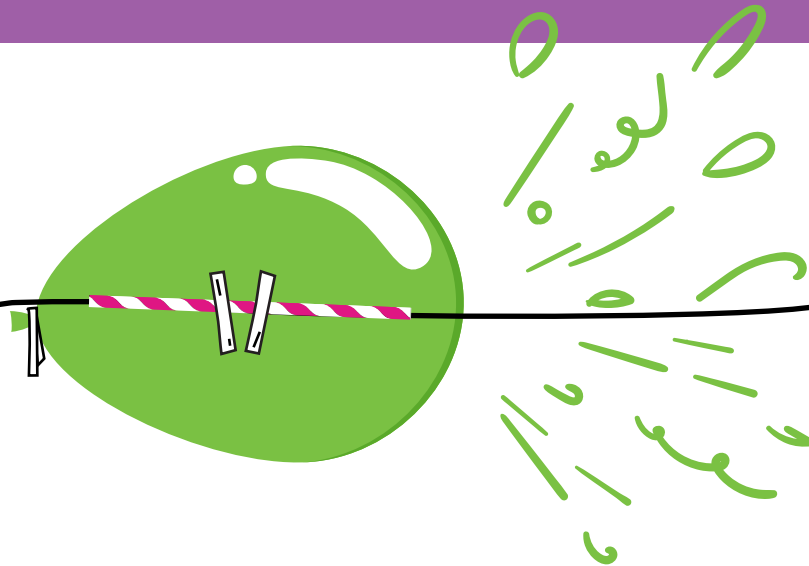


STEM

BALLOON ROCKET

When you spark your child's curiosity and imagination, you're helping set them up to be a lifelong learner. You can start with this easy balloon rocket activity! It will help your kids learn about force, action and reaction.



WHAT YOU'LL — Need —

- 1 balloon
- Yarn or string (about 6 feet)
- 1 drinking straw
- Tape
- Scissors
- 2 chairs

— INSTRUCTIONS —

- 1 String the drinking straw on the yarn.
- 2 Place the chairs apart from each other.
- 3 Stretch the yarn between the two chairs.
- 4 Tie the ends of the yarn to the chairs.
- 5 Inflate the balloon, leaving the end untied (hold onto it or pinch the end with a clip).
- 6 Attach the balloon to the straw on the string using two strips of tape.
- 7 Pull the balloon to one end of the yarn.
- 8 Let the balloon go!
