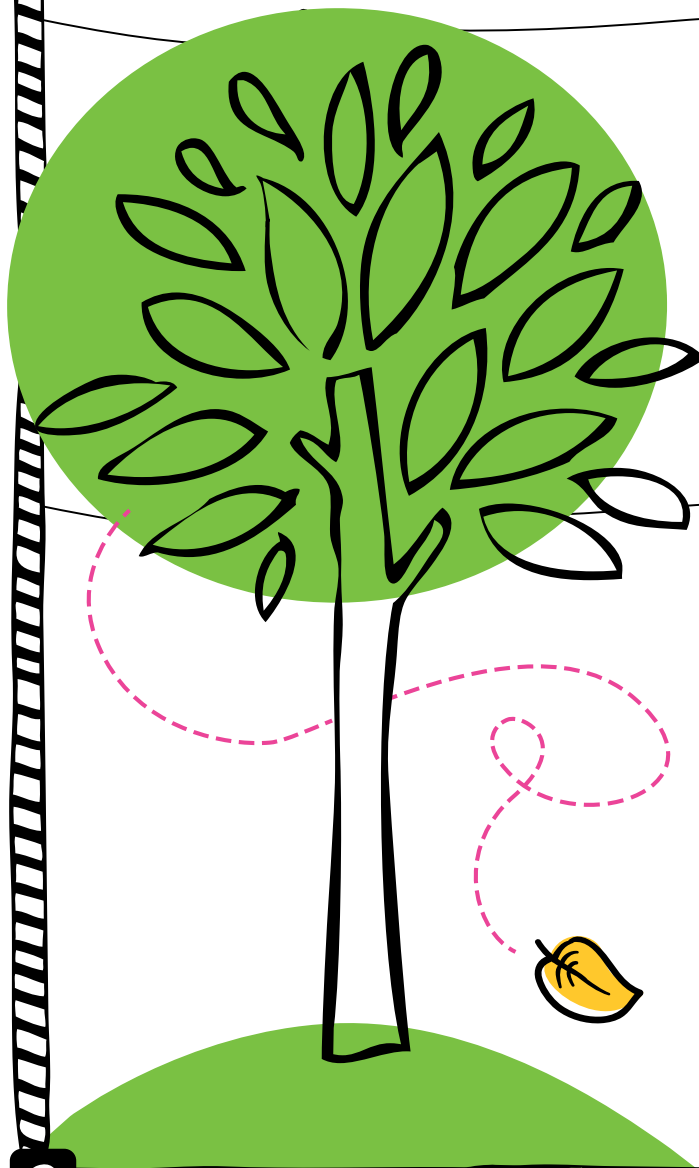

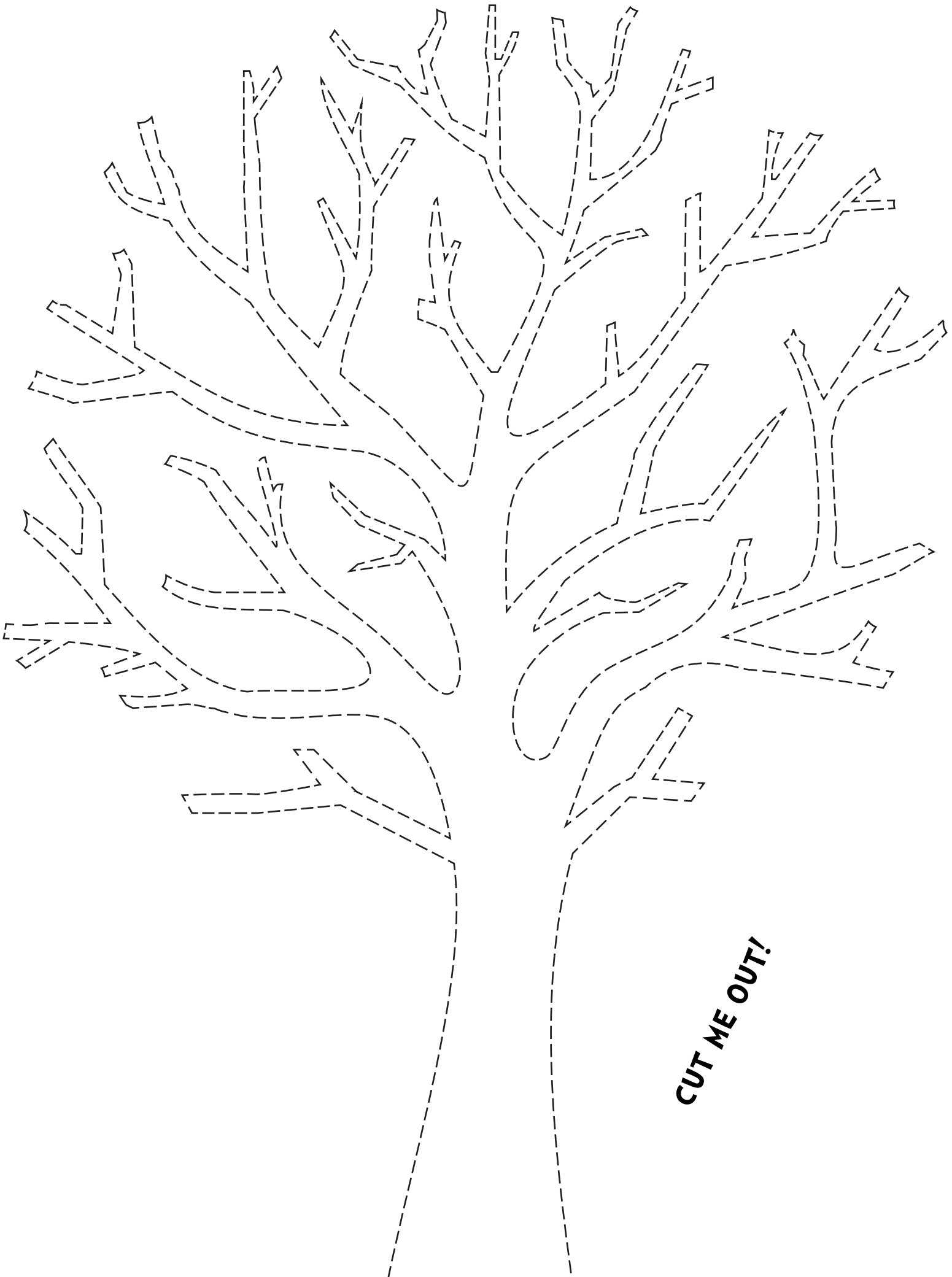

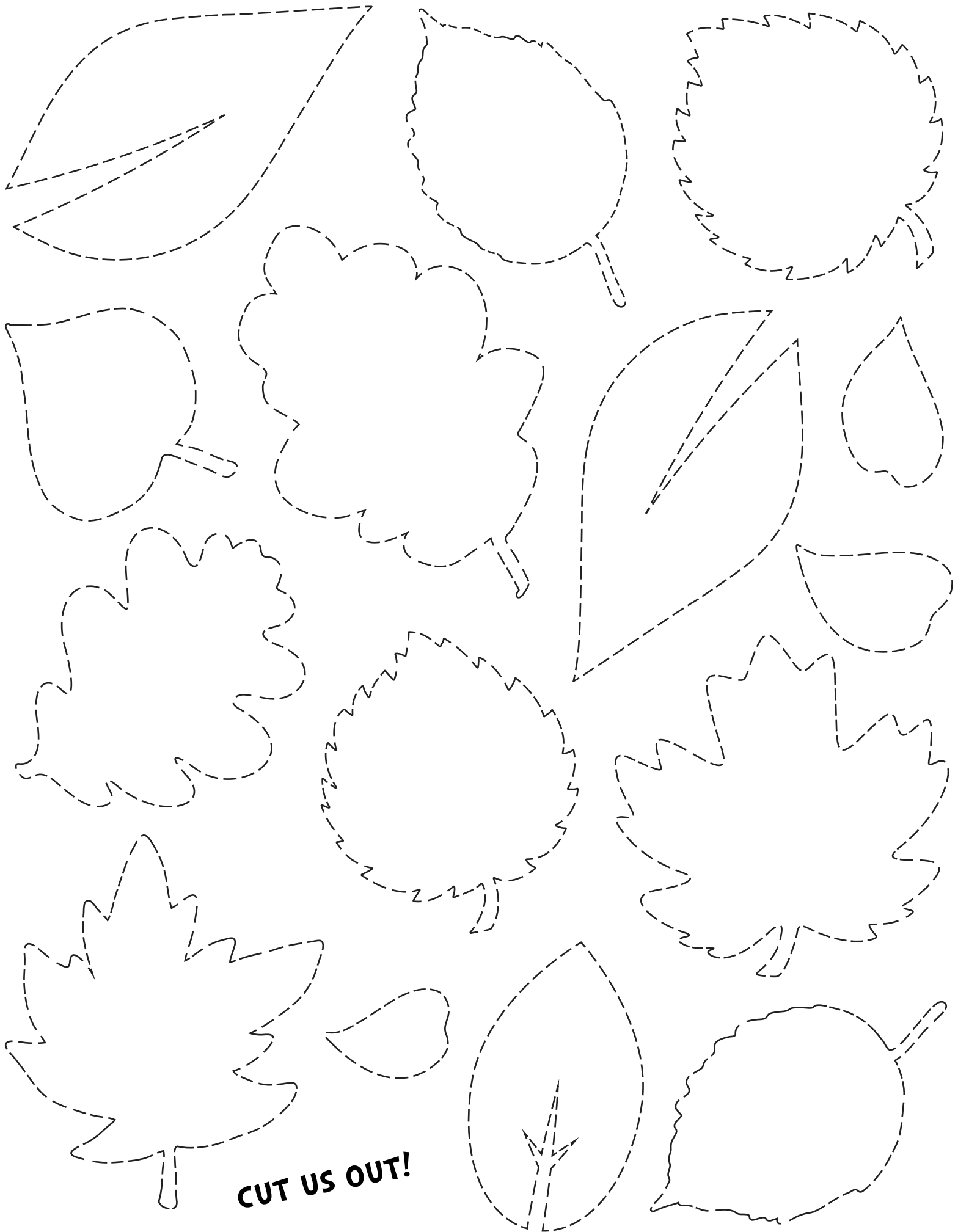
INSTRUCTIONS
